I N G R E D I E N T S

Ground Soybean Hulls 18.05%, Soybean Meal, Steam Flaked Corn, Steam Rolled Barley, Steam Rolled Oats, Cane Molasses, Canola Pellets, Safflower Meal, Hydrolized Animal and Vegetable Fat, Sunflower Seeds, Ground Limestone, Corn Gluten Meal, Corn Mill By-Product, Ground Corn, Ammonium Chloride, Dried Whey, Methionine Hydroxy Analogue - Calcium, Salt, Magnesium Chloride, Phosphoric Acid, Vegetable Oil, Hydrochloric Acid, Propionic Acid (Preservative), Propylene Glycol, Natural and Artificial Flavors, Iron Amino Acid Complex, Vitamin E Supplement, Active Dried Yeast(*Saccharomyces Cerevisiae*), Magnesium Oxide, Sodium Sulfate, Hydrolyzed Yeast, Yeast Extract, Rice Bran, Wheat Millrun, Sucrose, Sodium Sulfite, Starch, Zinc Hydroxychloride, Potassium Sulfate, Gelatin, Calcium Sulfate, Soybean Oil, Sodium Bentonite, Manganese Hydroxychloride, Beta Carotene, Calcium Hydroxide, Dried *Bacillus Subtilis* Fermentation Product, Cobalt Glucoheptonate, Mineral Oil, Vitamin A Supplement, Soybean Lecithin, Sodium Molybdate Dihydrate, Dried *Bacillus lichenformis* Fermentation Product, Chromium Propionate, Silicon Dioxide, Vitamin D3 Supplement, Ethylenediamine Dihydriodide, Sodium Selenite.

F E E D I N G D I R E C T I O N S

Feed to young sheep as a top dress or mix into the daily ration at the rate of 2.0 pounds per one hundred pounds of bodyweight daily, to supply 22.7 milligrams of Decoquinatate per one hundred pounds of bodyweight daily. Feed at least 28 days during periods of coccidiosis exposure or when experience indicates that coccidiosis is likely to be a hazard.

Feed to young sheep at a rate of 2 pounds per one hundred pounds of body weight per day to provide 18.18 mg Diflubenzuron per one hundred pounds of bodyweight per day (0.40 mg/kg of body weight/day).

CAUTION: Follow label directions. Feeding added selenium at levels in excess of 0.3 ppm in the total diet is prohibited. This feed contains 0.35 ppm of added Selenium so do not exceed 85.7% of this feed in the total ration.

REMINDER: Feed is perishable. Store this product in a cool, dry area away from insects. DO NOT feed moldy or insect-infested feed.
